## Condition Report

380. The tankard is in generally good condition with no significant damage. Typical light surface scratches and wear commensurate with age. No apparent erasures or thin areas. Engraved monogram to front. Hinge lid is good with small dent to one side and part marks to inner rim.

Handle is in good order with minor dent to one edge and markers mark half way down.

Body in good condition with a couple of minor dents and dent to skirted foot edge.

Good clear hallmarks to right of handle. Small lead repair to underside.
