A Chinese famille verte porcelain ginger jar, early 20th century, of compressed ovoid form, painted with dragons amidst peony, height 12cm, together with a Chinese porcelain figure, height 25.5cm, two porcelain brushpots, height 11.8cm and 12.5cm, a bamboo brushpot, height 17.7cm, and a Japanese blue glazed porcelain circular jar and cover with gilt decoration, diameter 22.2cm.

Condition Report

1185. Famille verte ginger jar - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical minor surface scratches and wear to enamels and glaze.

Figure - generally good condition, a little dusty and dirty so would certainly benefit from a clean. Typical light surface scratches and wear to enamels and gilt. Missing what he would have been holding in his right hand.

Cylindrical brushpot - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical light surface wear.

Rectangular brushpot - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Some wear to decoration and would benefit from a clean.

Bamboo brushpot - generally good with numerous vertical shrinkage splits, but nothing too significant.

Blue and gilt jar and cover - generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. No cracks or restoration. Typical light wear to gilt and glaze. Some minor areas of darker misfiring to rim of lower section.

Interior decoration in good order.
