A Chinese Ming style hardwood yoke back armchair, probably 19th century, with scroll top rail and armrests, the S-shaped splat inset with a rectangular marble panel above a rattan seat, on turned legs united by stretchers, height 93.5cm (minor faults).

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

1027. Top rail broken off at some point and re-glued, and some damage repaired where it was broken. Repaired section to lower part of mable panel. Splits to both handrests. Typical scuffs and wear. Some areas of wear and holes to cane seat, and some minro filler/repairs around edge of seat. Otherwise, chair is in fairly good structural condition.
