A pair of Japanese cloisonné enamel bottle vases, Meiji period, each ovoid body and flared narrow neck decorated with a sparrow and blossoming branches on a pale blue ground, unsigned, height 30.1cm (one with chip/loss to shoulder).

Condition Report

1091. Vase 1 - good condition, typical light surface scratches and minor misshaping to metal mounted rim. Small enamel flake/chip behind metal footrim.

Vase 2 - 2cm area of enamel loss/chip to shoulder, also hairlines/bruises to neck and just below rim. Typical light surface scratches and wear.

Both with good vibrant colours.
