A pair of Chinese famille rose export porcelain circular dishes, Yongzheng/Qianlong period, each painted with a central lotus spray within a rim of peony, lotus and chrysanthemum, diameter 28.7cm (rim restoration to both).

### Condition Report

1055. Dish 1 - 7cm hairline to central area of dish. Tiny chip to rim and several repaired/restored chips to rim with overpainting. The overpainting was obviously done some time ago, as it is yellowing. Some typical wear to enamels, but overall decoration is good, bright and vibrant.

Dish 2 - 8.5cm star crack to central area of dish. Two areas of yellowed overpainting to rim, where presumably chips/fritting has been restored. Otherwise ok. Typical minor wear to enamels, but overall decoration is good, bright and vibrant.
