A small collection of Chinese jade jewellery, mostly 20th century, including a pale celadon archer's ring, diameter 2.3cm, a pale celadon and russet cong bead, length 3cm, three interlocked circle pendants and a bead necklace with glass spacers and silver clasp.

Condition Report

1141. Cong shaped bead has a chipped/polished out corner, otherwise ok.
Stone pendant with some slight uneven areas to surface, but otherwise ok.
Archer's ring is slightly irregular in shape and has a russet hairline in it.
All other pieces in good order.

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
