351. Generally good condition, small dent and tiny hole to front cartouche where it has obviously had a knock. Otherwise typical light surface scratches and wear to highpoints. Hinge is good and lid closes tightly. Glass liner fits well and in good order. Good clear hallmarks. Sits flat.
