Condition Report

366. Good condition, no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear, but engraving still nice and crisp. Sits nice and flat with no wobbles. Hinge is good and closes tightly, with only minor lateral play. Good clear full hallmark to top of lid and part mark to side of body. Glass liner a good fit and in good condition.

Spoon in good condition.
