## Condition Report

368. Good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surfaces scratches and minor wear to highpoints. Piercing and embossing otherwise good. Hinge is good with some minor lateral play, but sits down nicely to the body. Glass liner is a good fit and in good order. Good clear full hallmark to top of lid and part mark to body.
