A near pair of Victorian silver mustards of lobed cylindrical form, each with domed hinged lid and pierced thumbpiece, pierced sides and beaded borders, Sheffield 1855 and 1871 by Henry Wilkinson & Co, heights 8.2cm and 7.9cm, together with a silver Fiddle pattern mustard spoon, Dublin 1854, and a silver Old English pattern mustard spoon, Birmingham 1911, total weight 300.9g.

Condition Report

374. Both mustards in good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear. One with slightly more play to hinge, but otherwise both good with lids closing tightly. Piercing is good. One with minor dent to footrim. Both with good clear hallmarks. Both glass liner in good order and fit well. Both sit flat with no wobbles.

Spoons are ok.
