An early Victorian silver cylindrical mustard, the engraved hinged lid with engraved thumbpiece above cast and pierced gothic arch decoration, flanked by a scroll handle, on a similarly decorated foot, Birmingham 1851 by Cartwright & Hiron, height 8.2cm, with a cranberry glass liner, together with a silver Fiddle and Shell pattern mustard spoon, Birmingham 1829, total weight 120.4g.

Condition Report

363. Generally good clean condition with no significant damage or repairs, only typical light surface scratches and wear. Hinge is good with only minor lateral movement and lid closes tightly. Sits nice and flat with no wobbles. Only very minor misshaping to footrim, but nothing significant. Good clear hallmarks. Glass liner fits well and is in good order.

Spoon ok with good clear marks, engraved monogram.
