### LOT 1160

A Jaeger-LeCoultre Atmos mantel timepiece, the signed perpetual gilt brass movement numbered '508600', the black circular chapter ring with gilt Roman hour numerals, the case with curved front, back and sides, cornered with black pillars, on a plinth base, height 22.5cm.

Estimate: £400 - £600

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### Condition Report

1160. The Atmos is in generally good condition. After a 2-hour test it is running well and keeping good time, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

Gilt brass case in generally good order with typical light surface scratches and wear, also some light pitting. Clear Perspex front door closes tightly and other Perspex side panels in good order.

As can be seen in the online images, one of the black corner inserts (to front right corner) is missing, so another one will need to be acquired/made or one from the back corner swapped over.

No travel/carry case present.

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
