A Jaeger-LeCoultre mini Reverso steel and gold lady's wristwatch, Ref. 140.106.5, the signed gilt dial with baton hour markers and black hands, the case back numbered '140 106 5' above '1599949 Q', the crocodile strap with signed steel buckle, case width 1.5cm, with Jaeger-LeCoultre box.

Estimate: £1,000 - £1,500

Condition Report

1065. The watch appears to be in good cosmetic order with no significant damage or repairs, only very minor surface scratches to case visible under magnification.

It is a quartz movement and is not currently running, may require a battery replacement but cannot guarantee this.

The dial looks to be in good clean order.

Case has some slight discolouration to the gold front.

Reverso mechanism works well.

Strap probably a replacement but has JLC buckle.

We cannot give date of manufacture, would suggest it may be 1990s but please do not rely on this.

It has a rectangular box (which has been written on), but no paperwork.

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
