An Omega Automatic De Ville 18ct gold circular cased gentleman's wristwatch, circa 1968, the signed and jewelled 565 caliber movement numbered '26409965', the signed silvered dial with gilt baton hour markers and date aperture, the signed case back interior numbered '1665020', the case back with engraved inscription, London 1967, case diameter 3.4cm, on an expanding gilt metal fronted bracelet.

Estimate: £400 - £600

Condition Report

1130. Typical surface scratches and wear. Engraved inscription to case back. Glass is scratched and worn. The dial appears to be in generally good order, other than some slight discolouration behind baton at 3 o'clock (beside aperture).

Winds and adjusts smoothly and is currently running, date rolls over as it should, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch..

Quite obviously not a genuine bracelet.
