Condition Report

1188. Generally good condition, a bit dusty and dirty. Typical minor scuffs and nicks, but no significant damage or repairs. Mercury present in both tubes and appears to be working. Bevelled glass in good order and dial a little dirty. Minor piece of moulding missing to one side just above cistern cover.
