LOT 1152

An early 20th century French lacquered brass carriage clock with eight day movement striking hours and half hours on a gong, the silvered dial with black Roman hour numerals and outer Arabic minutes, the architectural case with foliate centred swing handle, arched top and dentil cornice above four foliate capped columns and bevelled glass panels, on a stepped plinth base, height 21.7cm, with winding key.

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

1152. The case is in generally good condition, a little dusty and dirty but no significant damage or repairs. Some slight discolouration to gilt lacquer on case and typical light surface scratches and wear. One glass side panel has a tiny chip to top left corner, but not at all obvious and other glass panels are good. Back door and hinge are good.

Silvered dial in generally good condition. Adjusts smoothly and strikes on gong, but it does not wind and does not run at present.

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
