A Doxa Automatic SUB 300T Sharkhunter stainless steel gentleman's diver's bracelet wristwatch, Ref. 58098-59, circa 1970s, the signed black dial with luminous hour markers and date aperture, the case with rotating bezel, the case back with Synchron emblem and numbered '718837' above '58098-59' and '33110', the tapered link bracelet with Synchron foldover clasp, case width 4.3cm.

Condition Report

1125. As can be seen in the online images, case has scratches and wear, with particular wear to bezel. Crystal/glass with scratches, a couple of minor nicks/chips to edge, and a slightly larger chip at 1 o'clock, but no cracks.

Bezel with wear but rotates smoothly.

Bracelet and clasp with typical surface scratches and wear, but otherwise good and clasp in working order.

Dial generally good with some minor scratches/marks, slight degrading to luminous hour markers and hands.

Winds and adjusts smoothly, date rolls over as it should from crown, and it is currently running, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.
