An Art Deco marble, onyx, glass and spelter figural mantel clock with eight day movement striking on a bell via an outside countwheel, the silvered lozenge shaped dial with black Arabic hour numerals and inscribed 'Lepage Le Havre', the geometric case flanked by a detachable silvered and gilt spelter figure of a seated lady, on a rectangular plinth base, height 30cm, length 55.5cm, with pendulum and winding key.

Condition Report

1177. Clock winds smoothly and is currently running, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

It strikes crisply on the hour and half hour.

Dial in good order.

Chromed front door opens and closes nicely with some minor wear to chrome.

Figure is detachable with wear to silvering.

We feel the glass panel is later as we think the figure would have been attached to the marble.

Case otherwise ok but chips to edge of onyx and minor nicks/chips to edges of marble etc.
