## Condition Report

1209. Generally good condition. Typical surface scratches and wear to brass. Silvered dial and scales generally good, but with some wear and marks. Some dirt spots to underside of glass, but glass otherwise ok. Bubble level has dried out. Hinges to folding sights are good and smooth. Hinge lid has become detached from mahogany case so would need attention.
