Eighteen named blue banded T.G. Green Cornish Kitchen Ware storage jars and covers, each with black printed shield mark, comprising an extra large example, height 17.5cm, two large, height 16cm, five medium, height 14cm, three small, height 12.5cm, and seven spice jars and covers (one spice jar cover damaged).

Estimate: £150 - £200

Condition Report

Overall the jars and covers are in good condition with no cracks, chips or restoration. There is some very light and minimal staining, nothing untoward or unsightly. Some of the covers to the larger jars are not a great fit.

The 'Pepper' spice jar is very stained overall.

The 'Spice' spice jar has a very small manufacturing blemish to the edge of the lowest blue band, nothing terrible.

One of the spice jar covers is broken in two, glued and with chipping and staining.
