A pair of Moorcroft Pottery Pomegranate pattern vases, circa 1912-14, maybe produced for Liberty, the baluster bodies with pale yellow/mottled green ground, impressed factory mark to bases with green painted signature, height 21cm (haircrack to neck of one).

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

One of the vases has an approximate 5cm long vertical haircrack running from the top rim edge, and alongside this 2 curved approx 2cm long haircracks and a shorter vertical haircrack. None of these are immediately apparent and are only noticeable on close inspection.

Otherwise both the vases are in good condition overall with no chips or restoration.

They each have typical overall crazing to the glaze, and there are some minor manufacturers blemishes to the glaze colours.

There are some very minor and light surface scratches.
