## Condition Report

In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

The gilding displays some minimal typical wear, but nothing terrible and for a vase of this nature is in remarkably good order.

As is normal with Fairyland there are some typical small scratches (appearing as white marks) and some manufacturing blemishes to the glazed ground, again nothing terrible.
