A small group of Royal Crown Derby 2451 Japan pattern Imari wares, 1920s, comprising six plates, diameter 15.8cm, teapot and cover, jug and two-handled sugar bowl and cover (cracked), together with two Royal Crown Derby dishes, one of oval shape with acorn handles, length 23cm, the other of circular shape on a foot with gilt scroll handles, diameter including handles 23cm, and a Royal Crown Derby teacup and saucer.

Estimate: £70 - £100

Condition Report

Apart from the two handled sugar bowl and cover which (as catalogued) is badly cracked, each piece otherwise is in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

The gilding overall is good with no signs of wear.
