A pair of French porcelain vases, mid 19th century, the flared bodies painted with a girl feeding a peacock and a girl feeding swans, opposing floral arrangements, within relief gilt borders against a lime green ground, flanked by animal head handles, raised on integral shell and scroll moulded bases with gilt highlights, unmarked, height 29cm.

Condition Report

Both vases are in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

There is typical rubbing/wear to the gilding commensurate with age and handling, similarly the enamels display minor wear.
