A pair of Royal Worcester two-handled vases and covers, dated 1909 and 1910, the pear shaped bodies painted with pink roses within relief gilt borders, flanked by angular foliate gilt handles, the covers with pointed finials, puce printed and painted marks to bases, height 31cm (some faults and restoration).

Estimate: £120 - £180

Condition Report

First vase - there is a fine haircrack running across the diameter of the foot underside (through the factory mark) and it extends approx 4cm vertically up into the body of the vase beneath one of the rose panels. Otherwise this vase is in good condition.

Second vase - in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

First cover - the finial has been broken off and visibly repaired and in addition has chipping to its pointed tip.

Second cover - tip of finial chipped off.
