A Goldscheider terracotta wall mask, designed by Rudolf Knorlein, in the form of a lady with curly ginger hair holding a Venetian style mask, black printed marks and impressed '7081 8' to base, length 29cm, together with a Goebel Hummel pottery wall mask in the form of a lady with curly blonde hair wearing a varicoloured hat, impressed marks including 'FX966' to base, height 19cm.

## Condition Report

Goldscheider - in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. There is a minuscule glaze nick to one of the curls on the right side of the face - only noticeable on very close inspection. There is similarly a minuscule glaze nick to the side base edge of the yellow wristband, again only noticeable on very close inspection.

Goebel - in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration, overall crazing to the glaze.
