A Georges Despret pâte-de-verre yellow glass paperweight, 1900s, modelled in the form of a mask depicting a faun, possibly Pan, with some enamelled details, impressed mark, length 19cm (some faults).

Condition Report

There is a large crack running horizontally across the back of the paperweight between the ears, it encroaches each side of the face into the middle of the cheeks. Please see the images on our website using the zoom function.

The right horn would appear to be missing its tip, but due to the moulding it is difficult to identify what is happening.

As is the nature of this type of glass, there are manufacturers blemishes and air bubbles overall.
