### LOT 1877

Six assorted Bristol green glass wines, 19th century, including two roemers, together with a mixed group of other glassware, mostly 19th century, including two green glass finger bowl rinsers, five cranberry jugs, a dimpled turquoise jug, an opaline goblet, height 17.3cm, some honeycomb moulded glassware and two amethyst tinted wines with faceted stems (some faults). Provenance: from the collection of John and Poppy Stallebrass.

Estimate: £80 - £120

### Condition Report

Fundamentally the items in the lot are each in good condition overall with no damage or repairs.

The cut green decanter is missing its stopper, it has a minor nick to the top rim edge and a few tiny chips to the footrim.

One of the amethyst wines with the faceted stem has some minor nicks to the facet edges.

The tall lime green vase with wrythen moulding has some nicks to the neck rim interior.

The dark green hollow stem rummer with prunts to the stem exterior has scratching to the bowl and a reduced foot.
