A Royal Worcester ewer, dated 1900, painted by Hawkins, signed, with an arrangement of fruit within a gilt scroll frame surrounded by gilt foliate stems against a cobalt blue ground, the gilt handle formed as a pair of snakes, the foot and shoulders with white beaded border detail, green printed factory mark to base, height 24.5cm (restored), together with a Worcester pale blue ground two-handled vase, painted with flowers, green printed marks to base, height 21.5cm.

Condition Report

Hawkins ewer - there is professional restoration and regilding to the handles which would appear to have sustained a number of breaks along their length, there is similar restoration to a break at the top of the foot and some patches of regilding to the gilt edge of the foot.

Pale blue ground two handled vase - in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration, would benefit from a clean.
