A Belleek Chinese Tea Ware small teapot and cover, the body with overall chevron moulding, the spout in the form of a winged beast's head, angular handle, raised on three paw feet, painted '3' to base, otherwise unmarked, height 9cm (restored).

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

The whole of the beak and an associated part of the throat have been professionally (but in my opinion) poorly restored, the repainting and regilding are not well matched.

There is a small chip to the side edge of the foot beneath the handle.

There is some rust coloured staining to the interior of the pot which I believe would clean off.

The cover is in good condition.

Overall there is typical rubbing/wear to the enamels and gilding commensurate with age and handling.
