## LOT 1930

A Kosta glass vase, designed 1950s by Vicke Lindstrand, of flared canted square shape, the clear body with fine thread spirals of dark amethyst colour, engraved marks to base 'Kosta LS 637', height 15.5cm, together with an Exbor glass vase of pale green/blue tint, designed by Oldrich Lipsky, acid etched mark to base, height 15.3cm (some bruises to Exbor vase).

## Condition Report

Kosta - one of the base corners has a couple of teeny tiny grazes to it, most easily seen with an eyeglass. There is an approx 0.5cm long horizontal scratch to the middle of the body on one side, only noticeable on close inspection. No repairs or significant damage.

Exbor - 2 small chips to one of the wavy edges and another bruise/chip to one face near the top.
