A Continental cut glass lazy Susan, late 19th century, the rotating circular top with cut diamond pattern within a raised scalloped edge, held with metal mounts in the domed glass foot, diameter of top 42cm.

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

In good condition overall with no significant damage or repairs.

There is a narrow flat chip to the top of the vertical glass collar which the upper section rotates on, this is only visible when you view the underside of the top section straight on.

There are typical surface scratches to the upper surface commensurate with age and use.
