A pair of Meissen figures, late 19th century, modelled after Acier as a girl looking down on a broken mirror at her feet, height 15.2cm, and a boy holding his hand to his mouth, standing before a column, height 16cm, both raised on circular bases moulded with a scroll pattern to the edge, picked out in gilding, crossed swords in underglaze blue to bases with incised shape Nos. F34.

Estimate: £200 - £300

## Condition Report

Both figures are in very good condition overall.

The boy has a tiny nick to the front lower edge of his base beneath his right foot and a similar minor nick to the inner side edge of his pink coat by his right hand. Otherwise there are no cracks, chips or restoration.
