A Meissen figure group, late 19th/early 20th century, modelled as a gentleman seated on rocks beside a standing female smelling a flower from a basket of other flowers she is holding, a dog at their feet, on a gilt enriched scroll moulded mound base, crossed swords in underglaze blue to base with incised shape No. 2987, height 19cm (minor faults).

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

There are some sections of branch/bocage missing from the backs of the figures, there are associated small grazes/losses to the left elbow of the male figure and the right elbow and gathered apron of the female I guess where some bocage or branches would have met the figures?

He has a glued repair to the shoe of his right foot through the instep.

Otherwise in good condition.
