LOT 1459

A large Royal Worcester two-handled vase and cover, dated 1900, the blush ivory ground decorated with flowers, the shoulders, neck, stem and base moulded with foliate scrollwork and stiff leaf bands against a pale green ground, flanked by elaborate scroll handles with mask terminals, the circular foot on a square base, the cover with pointed finial, green printed and impressed marks to base, shape No. 1572, height 47cm (pointed finial restored).

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

The vase itself is in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. The gilding and enamels are good.

The finial of the cover has a glued repair to a clean break where it joins the green glazed section of the cover, the gilt pointed section of the finial is poorly re-gilt and possibly made-up.
