A Loetz vase, 1920s, designed by Michael Powolny, the white body with black vertical line decoration, unmarked, height 15cm, together with three pieces of Tango glass, comprising a basket, a black footed orange bowl and a yellow vase on pulled black feet, height 19.5cm. Provenance: from the collection of John and Poppy Stallebrass.

Estimate: £120 - £180

Condition Report

Black and white vase - the outer base edge of the foot has a polished chip, more easily felt than seen but noticeable as the vertical black line disappears a little and then reappears. There are some small manufacturers blemishes and air bubbles to the glass overall, and some surface scratches primarily to the widest part of the body.

Footed orange bowl - the interior of the bowl is pitted overall and there are some teeny tiny nicks to the edge of the foot.

The basket and vase are in good condition overall, again with some minor manufacturers blemishes to the glass but no damage or repairs.
