A pair of Royal Doulton stoneware vases, early 20th century, decorated with Art Nouveau sunflowers and beaded detail, impressed and incised marks to bases, height 35cm.

Condition Report

Both vases are in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

One has a glazed over concave manufacturing fault to the ochre glazed side edge of one of the larger flowers approx 2.3cm long by 1cm deep - it is not immediately visible as the colour of the body which can be seen blends in with the glazing of the vase, it can just be seen in image 1 on our website if you look at the space in between the two vases it is on the edge of the flower just visible on the left hand vase.
