A pair of faience pottery cats in the manner of Gallé, early 20th century, modelled seated, painted with flowers, wearing lace bonnets and gilt medallions with dog portraits, inset with green glass eyes, unmarked, heights 33cm and 34cm (minor faults and repairs).

Condition Report

We didn't catalogue these as Galle due to the absence of a mark.

Cat facing left - there is a hole to the underside of the back right paw, only visible when the cat is inverted. There is a glued repair to the ankle of the front left foot, none of the glaze is missing.

Cat facing right - in good condition overall with no damage or repairs.

Both cats have crazing to the glaze. Overall the enamels and gilding are good.
