An Art Deco Lalique opalescent glass Moissac pattern vase, circa 1930, of flared circular form with a relief leaf design, engraved 'No 992' and 'R. LALIQUE FRANCE' to base, height 13cm.

Estimate: £600 - £800

Condition Report

There are 2 very, very small indistinct nicks to the underside edge of the foot, only visible when the vase is inverted.

One of the larger leaves 3 down from the top rim has a small chip along its spine.

There are a number of tiny fleabite nicks to the inner circumference of the top rim.

One of the mould lines on the outer top rim edge is noticeable as a tiny manufacturing flaw.
