A Carter & Co Ltd Poole & London Pottery paperweight or wall plaque, early 20th century, modelled as the head of a winged putto or cherub, covered in a mottled and splashed iridescent glaze of predominantly purple and green colouring but with caramel detail to the top of the head, impressed factory mark, height 10cm.

Condition Report

The very tip of the relief left wing has a minuscule spot of glaze rubbing to it.
A hole has been drilled to the reverse above the mark, presumably for hanging on a wall.
Otherwise in good condition with no damage or repairs.
