An Art Deco Moser Alexandrit (Alexandrite) glass candlestick of faceted, tapered column shape, acid etched mark to base, height 19.3cm, together with a Moser amethyst tint circular glass box and cover with Oroplastic decoration, engraved mark to base, diameter 10.5cm, a similar amber glass vase, unmarked, height 12.3cm, and a Moser glass paperweight, engraved with a grazing zebra, acid etched mark to base, height 20cm. Provenance: from the collection of John and Poppy Stallebrass.

Condition Report

Candlestick - in good condition overall with no damage or repairs.

Box and cover - has a minuscule blemish to the side edge of the cover which I think is probably a manufacturing issue, it is tiny and really only noticeable on close inspection, otherwise in good condition.

Vase - there is a teeny tiny nick to the outer top rim edge, only noticeable on VERY close inspection, otherwise ok.

Paperweight - in good condition overall with no damage or repairs, there is some gilt detail to the grass which is not maybe as bright as it once was.
