Condition Report

Dancing girl - in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. Typical light wear.

Dancing boy - the lower half of his pipe is (poorly) restored and subsequently the tips of the fingers of the right hand, the left pocket flap of his jacket has a glued repair and chip. Typical light wear.

John Bull - two small nicks to hat and rubbing to gilding, otherwise ok.

Seated girl - ok

Seated boy - poor restoration to hat brim and glued repairs to one back leg and two stretchers of chair.
