A large Royal Worcester blush ivory ground jardinière, dated 1898, of bulbous shape with floral decoration after Edward Raby, monogrammed, above moulded detail of pale green glazed leaves and panels, the neck rim with moulded flowerheads, puce printed and impressed marks to base, shape No. 1925, height 26cm (riveted repair to base).

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

A large (almost) circular shaped section of the base has been broken out and visibly riveted back, the foot diameter is 25cm and the diameter of the broken out section is 12.5cm.

Otherwise the jardiniere is in good condition.
