LOT 1491

A Royal Worcester Japanesque pierced aesthetic moonflask, 1870s, of flattened circular shape, one side decorated with a monkey amidst prunus blossom, the other with a magnolia tree, both within geometric framing heightened in shot enamels and gilding, the sides flanked by relief pierced lappet sections, raised on four scroll feet, indistinct impressed marks, height 17.5cm (small glued repair to one relief section).

Estimate: £150 - £200

Condition Report

Both 'bat' shaped protrusions at the tip of each relief lappet section at the top of the vase have glued repairs with some minor repainting.

There is a teeny tiny flat nick to the top rim edge of the vase by the central aperture.

The feet have some wear to the enamels.

Otherwise ok.

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
