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A gold, silver, emerald and diamond cluster ring, 19th century, mounted with the rose cut oval emerald within a surround of ten rose cut diamonds, with beaded shoulders, unmarked, weight 2.8g, ring size approx M1/2, with a case.

Estimate: £500 - £700

Condition Report

The emerald has typical abrasion to the facet edges, with numerous inclusions, some dark in appearance. Emerald size approx. 7.5mm x 5.7mm.

Some wear to diamond surrounds.

Due to the nature of the setting and the style of cut it is not possible to provide a total carat weight of the diamonds with any accuracy, they appear to range from 0.05ct to 0.10ct each when viewed using a gauge. There is a possibly that the piece is a marriage, the head of the ring of earlier date than the shank.

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
