A pair of gold and jade pendant earrings, 1930s, each mounted with a jade drop carved with fruit, below a chain with cross motif and cabochon jade surmount, with screw fittings, detailed '14K', weight 4.7g, length 4.1cm, with a case.

Estimate: £400 - £500

Condition Report

A few surface reaching inclusions to the jades, particularly to the cabochons.

One cabochon has a chip to the girdle/underside visible when viewed from the side when using a x10 loupe.

Light surface wear overall.

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
