### LOT 531

A small group of silver and other jewellery, including a gold heart shaped pendant locket, mounted with a half-pearl, detailed 'Real Gold', weight 3.4g, a yellow metal oval pendant locket, detailed 'Metal 9ct Frames', weight 2.8g, a Victorian silver, bloodstone and cornelian rotating pendant fob, an oval hinged bangle, Birmingham 1961, and a silver, silver gilt and synthetic blue spinel bangle.

Estimate: £60 - £100

### Condition Report

Oval hinged bangle - very small dent to the back, safety chain broken

Hammered bangle - misshaped

Spinel bangle - slightly misshaped, abrasion/chipping to spinel

Identity bracelet - engraved 'Rosemary' to front, 'Peter' to back, clasp possible replacement, very flimsy compared to the rest of the bracelet

Two stone cabochon bracelet - one cabochon chipped/bruised

Rotating fob - one or two small nicks to edges of stones, small dent to beaded decoration

Oval locket - dented, lacking interior glazing, replacement suspension loop

Blue paste single stone necklace - paste badly chipped

Clip earrings - one lacking central stone

Coral bar brooch - some solder repairs

Heart locket (silver) - some wear to engraved decoration and dented

Filigree brooch - front section slightly dented inwards

Amethyst ring - one amethyst lacking

Other pieces are in fairly good condition, with no significant damage.

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
