An early George III flame mahogany linen press, attributed to Gillows of Lancaster, the dentil moulded pediment above a pair of doors with applied mouldings and carved palmette corner crestings, the base with dummy front drawers above a single drawer, height 199cm, width 133cm, depth 66cm (alterations). 2174. General condition and appearance is good throughout, however, the pediment has probably been altered having had a blind fretwork frieze taken off it, as well as the interior being altered. There is now only the lower drawer and the rest of the interior is fitted for hanging space.
