An 18th century Spanish Colonial walnut hall bench, the two-plank top above slatted sides, fitted with two sliding panels, height 50cm, width 169cm, depth 44cm.

Condition Report

2240. The top has some fairly typical surface cracks and a repair to one corner. There are some old but later nails applied to each corner of the frieze panels. One of the vertical slats is missing and one of them is a replacement. The sliding panels are quite worn, as are the grooves that they sit in, but they still just about work. Otherwise overall scuffs, marks and wear.
