A small group of jewellery, including a sterling silver and varicoloured paste set brooch, width 4.1cm, a sterling silver and colourless paste brooch in a fanned design, four souvenir photographic book charms, including one entitled 'Brighton', six rings and an amber chert holder, with a case.

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

Fan brooch - one paste lacking

Dragon brooch - general losses to polychrome decoration, pin fastening bent

Bar brooch - bent

Chert holder - flat chip to aperture end, case in generally good order

Imitation pearl ring - losses to pearl coating, four gems lacking

Marcasite panel ring - some marcasites lacking

Solitaire paste ring - paste chipped, abraded

Blue paste cluster ring - some abrasion to pastes

Buttons - one central section lacking, some nibbles to pastes

Enamelled charm - lacking gemstone

Bead necklace - needs restringing, lacking clasp, some wear

Amber beads - clasp broken

Souvenir books - each with some damage to the photographic images, rubbing, scratching, or coming loose

All other pieces in fair condition, typical wear and scratching overall.
